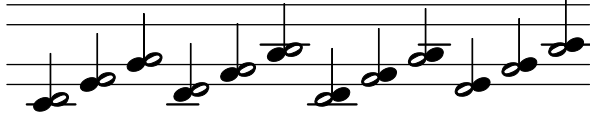


Intervals in Clairnote Music Notation

The intervals are arranged to highlight similarities in their appearance. Notice how the intervals in each row share certain visual characteristics. For example, the intervals on the bottom row always contain two solid notes or two hollow notes, the notes are always both on a line or both on a space, and the notes are in the same position relative to the nearest staff line (or ledger line).
